## **Extended Diversity Experience Program**

### 2019-2020 Academic Year

Are you a faculty member interested in incorporating what you learned about diversity and inclusive concepts into a course you will be teaching in the coming year? If so, consider applying for a spot in the Extended Diversity Experience program. This extended professional growth experience will connect you to a cohort of faculty who are interested in diversity, equity and inclusion issues, with liaison librarians who can find and utilize resources related to your teaching interests, and with pedagogy experts who will work collaboratively with you to transform your course.

To be eligible, you must have participated in Provost's Diversity Institute for Faculty Development series (2015-present), and/or diversity initiatives in your college/school/division. Preference will be given to those who have participated in multiple events. Because of the time commitment required for this professional development seminar, the number of faculty participants will be limited no more than 15 persons.

Faculty who are selected for the Extended Diversity Experience must participate in regular meetings throughout the fall and spring terms, to work closely with teaching consultants/instructional designers/liaison librarians on syllabus changes, course content enhancements, and revised classroom activities and assignments, and to share what they learn with colleagues.

#### Please note that:

- Regional campus faculty have the option to participate in person or via video conference.
- Participation in a formal assessment and poster presentation will be required at conclusion of the program.
- Stipends will be available to faculty who are on less than a 12-month contract.
