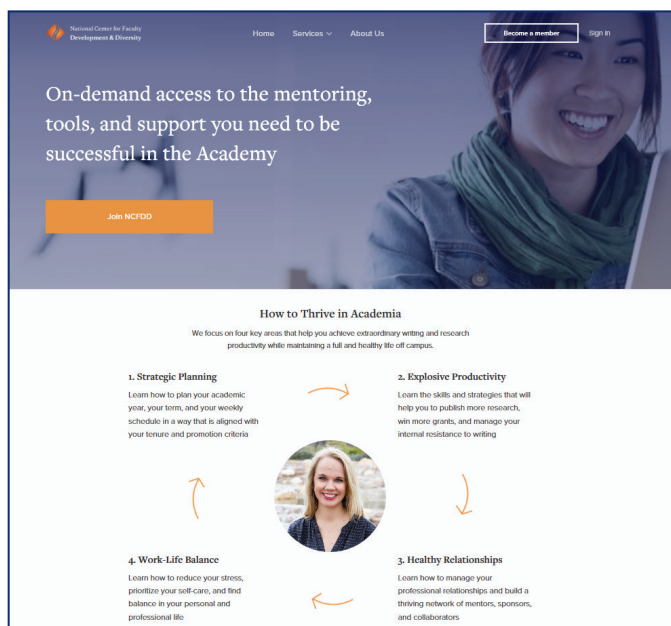




Connect with the National Center for Faculty Development and Diversity
