Teaching Surveys are administered by the Office of Measurement & Evaluation of Teaching (OMET) near the end of each term and are designed to assist faculty in gathering student feedback.



You can customize your survey by adding questions.



Students can access the survey through CourseWeb, My Pitt and the links are sent directly to their Pitt e-mail address.



You can monitor response rates throughout the survey period and are encouraged to talk to students about the process. You can also allow class time for students to complete surveys.




Results are available after the term is over and final grades have been posted.



The process to request a survey varies by School, check with your administration.
