Fully Online	Sync and Async	Online	None	<p>Classes of any size that do not require a hands-on, face-to-face component as in some labs, studios, internships, and clinicals</p> <p>Classes that are not assigned a classroom space</p> <p>Classes in which all students opt to participate fully online</p> <p>Classes with instructors who cannot participate in face-to-face instruction</p>
Majority Online	Sync and Async	Mostly online	All or most on the few occasions the class meets	<p>Classes of any size that do not require a significant hands-on, face-to-face component as in some labs, studios, internships, and clinicals</p> <p>Classes in which all students opt to participate mostly online</p> <p>Classes with instructors who cannot participate in face-to-face instruction consistently throughout the semester</p>
Separate Sections	Sync and Async	Either face-to-face or online	Some	<p>Large classes in which many, but not all, students opt to participate online.</p>
