Rotating Cohort	Sync and Async (rotating)	Face-to-face and online (rotating)	Some (rotating)	Large classes assigned classroom space that can only accommodate a portion of students at a time while adhering to social distancing guidelines Potentially labs, studios, internships, clinicals, depending on the course
Flipped Hybrid	Sync	Online and face-to-face (together)	Most	Small or mid-sized classes assigned classroom space that can accommodate social distancing guidelines Labs, studios, internships, clinicals
Fully Online	Sync and Async	Online	None	Classes of any size that do not require a hands-on, face-to-face component as in some labs, studios, internships, and clinicals Classes that are not assigned a classroom space Classes in which all students opt to participate fully online Classes with instructors who cannot participate in face-to-face instruction
Majority Online	Sync and Async	Mostly online	All or most on the few occasions the class meets	Classes of any size that do not require a significant hands-on, face-to-face component as in some labs, studios, internships, and clinicals Classes in which all students opt to participate mostly online Classes with instructors who cannot participate in face-to-face instruction consistently throughout the semester
Separate Sections	Sync and Async	Either face-to- face or online	Some	Large classes in which many, but not all, students opt to participate online.
