
Importing Content Selectively in Canvas

In Course Navigation, click Settings.



Click Import Course Content.




If importing **Blackboard Content**, in the Content Type drop-down menu, select the **Blackboard 6/7/8/9 export .zip file** option.



If importing **Canvas Content**, in the Content Type drop-down menu, select the **Copy a Canvas Course** option. *After choosing which course to copy from, skip to step 6*



Click **Browse** to choose your file.



Locate and **select** your exported Blackboard Course .zip file and click **Open**.

Your .zip file may appear in your computer's Downloads folder.



In the Default Question bank dropdown menu, select the Question bank you want to use for your question bank from blackboard. If you do not have a question bank you want to use, you can create a new question bank. In the drop-down menu, select **Create new question bank.**


7 Click the Select specific content option.



We recommend you **do not** choose to Overwrite assessment content with matching IDs or Adjust events and due dates and to change your due dates in your content manually once it is imported into Canvas.



Click the **Import** button.



10 If you imported Blackboard Content, under current jobs, you will see your zip file categorized as "Blackboard Learn". If you imported from a Canvas Course, you will see your file categorized as "Course Copy." It will be queued, run the import, and then tell you that it is Waiting for Selection. Click Select Content.



A popup window will appear and you can check off **only the content you wish to import**.

Please note that any Blackboard Grade Center columns AND categories will show up under "Assignments"



Click the **Select Content** button.



Congratulations!

You've successfully imported content selectively into your Canvas course! Your content will be located in your course based on the categories they were in in Step 11.

Note Some content (such as wikis or journals) are available in Blackboard but do not have a Canvas equivalent. After your import is complete, your *Completed* status may be orange and have a note next to your current jobs that lists issues importing content. If you click on the issues, it will list which content were not able to be imported.
