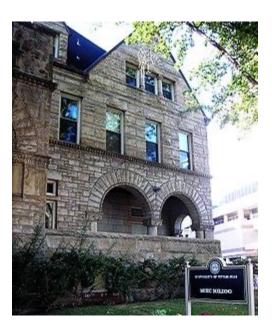

#### Collections & Access to Resources

The ULS seeks to maintain a balanced collection with global reach. We collect materials that represent diverse perspectives, and we endeavor to support and promote critical thinking and informed discussion in our community<sup>1</sup>.

- 5+ million titles held; nearly 2 million E-books
- Diversity of formats: print, e-journals, e-books, databases, books, technical standards, datasets, audio-video media, streaming content, media equipment









#### Collections - Area Studies

The African American Collection contains material on African Americans, Africans, and Caribbean cultures in the following disciplines: Arts, Education, History, Literature, Philosophy, Politics, Religion, Sociology, Sports, and Religion.

The East Asian Library Collection contains three sub-collections: Chinese Collection, Japanese Collection, and Korean Collection

The Eduardo Lozano Latin American Collection supports the research and teaching in Latin American Studies, particularly the interdisciplinary programs sponsored and coordinated by the Center for Latin American Studies (CLAS).



Awardees will develop independent reséarch projects that draw upon online primary resources, such as rare books, manuscripts, archivalorganizational records, found in the University of





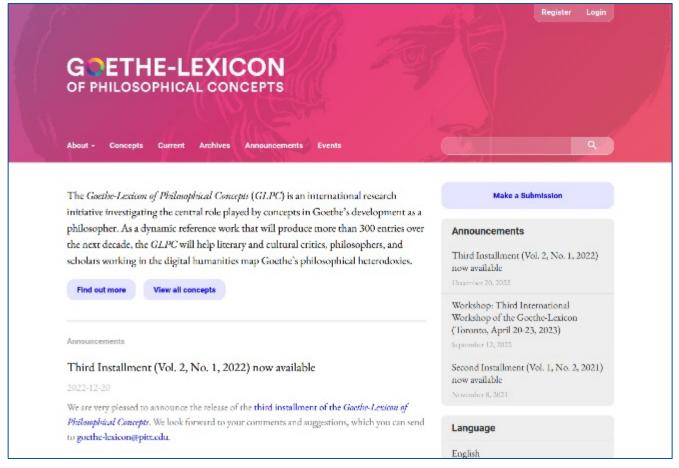
- Coding and Computational Support: Python, R, web scraping, Git, SQL, and more
- Research Data Services: Finding, cleaning, organizing, and working with data
- <u>Digital Creation and Stewardship</u>: Specialized digitization, 3D scanning, software for digital creation and creativity
- <u>Geospatial Data and Analysis</u> Mapping, Geographic Information Systems (GIS), and spatial analysis
- <u>Text Mining and Analysis</u>: Acquiring and analyzing textual data
- Web-Based Scholarship: Digital exhibits <u>using Omeka</u>, online portfolios, and multi-modal digital storytelling












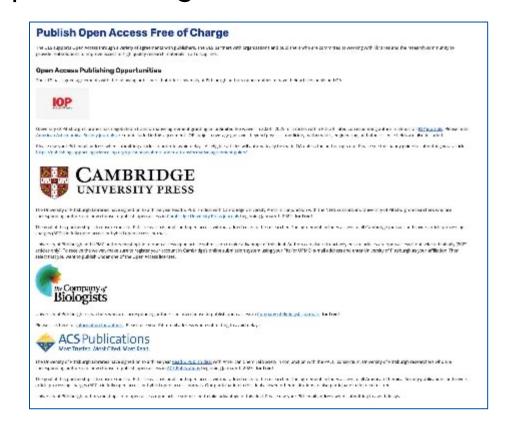
